



CLASSROOM STRATEGIES

FAILS TO CHANGE ONE MATHS OPERATION TO ANOTHER

- Use visual cues such as stop signs and red dots when the child must change operation.

- Use colour coding (e.g., make addition signs green, subtraction signs red, etc.). Gradually reduce the use of colours as the child demonstrates success.

- Make the maths operation symbols extra large in order that the child will be more likely to observe the symbols.

- Ask the child to go through the maths questions highlighting the operation of each problem before beginning to solve it.

- Have the child practice matching maths operation symbols to the corresponding word using flash cards (e.g., +, -, x, ÷, add, subtract, multiply divide).
