## **CLASSROOM STRATEGIES**

## **FAILS TO CHANGE ONE MATHS OPERATION TO ANOTHER**

Use visual cues such as stop signs and red dots when the child must change operation.
Use colour coding (e.g., make addition signs green, subtraction signs red, etc.). Gradually reduce the use of colours as the child demonstrates success.
Make the maths operation symbols extra large in order that the child will be more likely to observe the symbols.
Ask the child to go through the maths questions highlighting the operation of each problem before beginning to solve it.
Have the child practice matching maths operation symbols to the corresponding word using flash cards (e.g., +, -, x, ÷, add, subtract, multiply divide).
