



CLASSROOM STRATEGIES

WORKS MATHS PROBLEMS FROM LEFT TO RIGHT INSTEAD OF RIGHT TO LEFT

- Use large coloured arrows to indicate where the child begins to work a maths problem.
- Make certain the child understands that columns for the left are higher value than those to the right.
- Write the place value above each maths problem to remind the child to begin with the 'ones' column to solve the problem.
- Emphasise 'Reading begins on the left, maths begins on the right' in classes.
